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In July 2021, "The Wall Street Journal" reported the company's annual revenue to be approximately \$800 million with a loss of \$70 million. By May 2021, it was reported that the video-sharing app generated \$5.2 billion in revenue with more than 500 million users worldwide.",

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On September 6, 2021, TikTok collaborated with the BBC to launch a series called "Ask Me Anything." Users were able to submit questions about anything from their personal lives to what they thought about politics. The videos were branded with BBC's logo and had a link to the channel on the app. After the videos had been posted, the company announced that they would be taking action against any inappropriate content on the app. The company said that there were "two clear issues around our policy" and that they would be working to fix it. The first was that "the app is for 14+" and that children under 14 were able to register on the app even if they did not have consent from their parents. The second issue was a lack of enforcement when it came to inappropriate content in videos. Following this event, people under 18 were no longer able to create accounts on TikTok without consent from their parents or an adult guardian. The company also said that they wanted to give young people a platform to express themselves and help them understand that they can have fun but not in a way that could cause harm to others.",

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TikTok has been criticized for the amount of time it takes for users to upload videos and therefore can affect their ability to generate revenue from them. These issues have been compounded by the company's lack of oversight and a lack of in-app review or moderation tools available for its users. As of May 2021, the app has been criticized for the amount of inappropriate and illegal content shared on its platform and the ease with which users can access this content. TikTok is not monitored by human moderators as Youtube is but relies entirely on machine learning technology to find inappropriate content that violates its terms of service. It has been reported that this method provides overbroad or inappropriate results, as well as false positives.",

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On December 15, 2021, the company launched a version of TikTok for Android phones. The Android version of the app is available in 150 countries. In January 2021, the company launched TikTok Studio for iPhone and iPad devices to give users a more effective way to create videos in their homes or on location. The app was announced as a part of the "TikTok Music" feature that the company launched in August 2021. It also integrates with Record Labels such as Jingle Punks, Spinnin' Records, Monstercat and Deorro's Deoretik.",

TikTok was ranked by App Annie as one of the top most downloaded apps on both Google Play and the App Store during June 2021. It was most popular in India, Philippines and Indonesia. By July 2021, TikTok had reached 1 billion downloads on Google Play alone and over 300 million users who were active within a month. In August 2021, it was announced that TikTok had grown its userbase to 500 million; which is an increase of 100 million users since January 2021. In the same month, the app announced that it had been downloaded over 1 billion times on Google Play.",

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The app has been described as "the hottest thing on the Internet right now." Musical ly has seen significant growth in its userbase, with its total user numbers rising from 40 million in August 2021 to 100 million in January 2021 and 200 million by October 2021; it has also become one of the most-downloaded applications in the iOS App Store. Musical ly ranks among the top 50 social networks worldwide as of January 2021, reaching number 21 overall (number 15 in United States).",

In the past, there were rumors about the possible acquisition of TikTok by any of the major tech companies in the world. In February 2021, it was reported that Microsoft is currently pursuing a software deal with TikTok. The talks should be over soon.",

Musical.ly has been criticized for its safety features and how it handles content; as of January 2021, the company had over 100 million worldwide

users and close to three billion total video views. Safety and privacy concerns have also been raised about a number of high profile incidents within its community, including bullying, harassment, suicidal behavior, school shootings and self-harm. Teenagers and younger audiences who join Musical ly are often regarded as young, impressionable teens and young adults who are easy targets for cyberbullying; in response to this, the company has made efforts to combat this prevalent issue by investing in tools that detect bullying text or comments on an individual's account.",

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Older accounts can still watch user-generated videos, however they can not create or share any of their own. They are instead limited to just viewing what other people are posting through the app's various features. TikTok is available for download on iOS and Android platforms. Released in Japan, the first version of "TikTok" was optimized for iOS devices. Subsequently, it was released worldwide as a non-Japanese version named "TiK".",

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On December 19, 2021, TikTok introduced a feature called "Profile Verification" in India. The feature was made to allow users to verify their identity on the app by sending their government-issued identification card number to TikTok. The company announced that the feature would show up as an option in the parental control settings of people who had verified their identities. The feature was only available for people aged 18 and over and did not verify names or email addresses. In addition, the company said it would not use the information for any other purpose other than verifying age on the platform. In an interview with NDTV, Jigar Shah, CEO and founder of TikTok said that they had not created profiles in other countries and that verification was only meant to stop people from registering without giving any information. On August 2, 2021, TikTok stopped offering the feature stating "We have received feedback from a majority of our users who do not wish to share their ID card numbers. We will continue to develop other features that can match identities using information such as phone number or email address." The company said it would continue to consider adding the feature in the future with new technology."
